Inflammation and disease meeting summary

Inflammation is a common but multifaceted process that underlies diseases ranging from autoimmunity to obesity. This new and timely event will bring together leading researchers with an interest in inflammation from seemingly disparate fields to better understand the complex underlying biology across diseases. The meeting will emphasize discussions and interactions among the participants, to facilitate innovative thinking about cell types, mediators, and pathways in inflammation that may be applicable to their own area of research. Critically, it will forge collaboration to pursue new or previously intractable questions based on complementary expertise and mutual interest. The meeting will explore aspects of inflammation in five categories:

- * Inflammation in autoimmunity
- * Inflammation in infectious disease
- * Inflammation in metabolic disease
- * Inflammation in cancer
- * Inflammation in the nervous system
